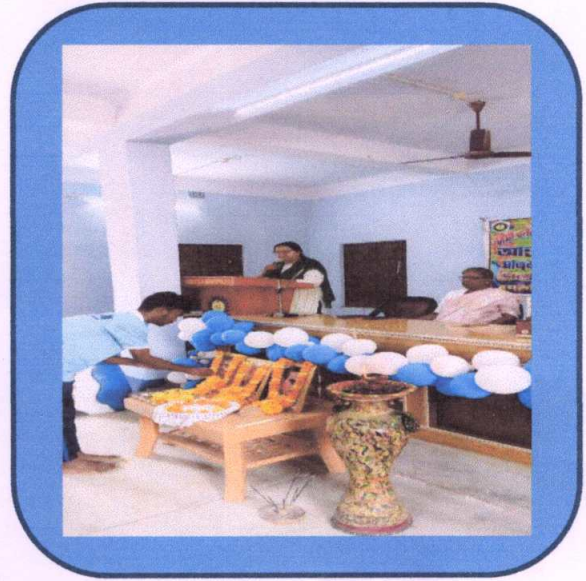
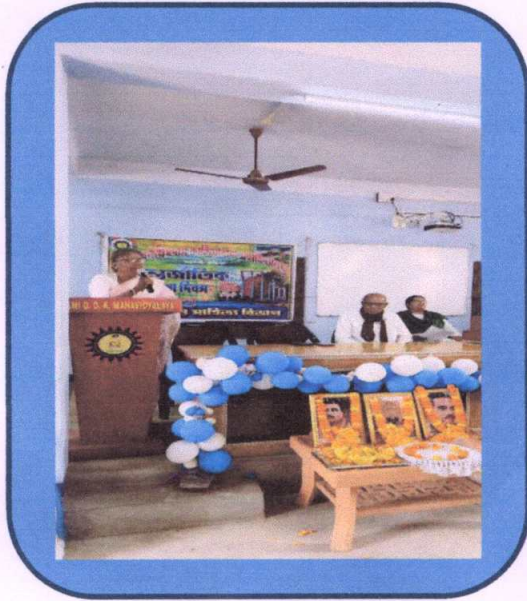
Both teaching and non-teaching staff members of the college also took part in the event, showcasing their support for the cause of linguistic diversity and cultural heritage.
