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Vision:

To evolve a higher education system that is suitably blended with provision for knowledge values and skill practice where every student learns in without sacrificing his/her creativity.

Why Choice Based Credit System (CBCS):

1. To develop "Learner-centric Approach" wherein students will be able to pick courses of their choice, understand, and learn at their own speed.
2. Can choose inter-disciplinary, intra-disciplinary, and skill-based courses.
3. May undertake as many credits as they can cope with (without repeating all courses in a given semester if they fail in one/more courses).
4. Makes education broad-based and at par with global standards. One can take credits by combining unique combinations. For example, Physics with Economics, Chemistry with environmental Science etc.
5. This system was adopted owing to the diversity of approaches with respect to examination, evaluation and gradation.
6. A uniform grading system will facilitate seamless mobility of students across institutions, in India and abroad.
7. It will also help potential employers, and will make the process easier when they have to assess the performance of students.
8. Flexibility for students to study at different times and at different institutions to complete one course. Credits earned at one institution can be transferred to another institution.
