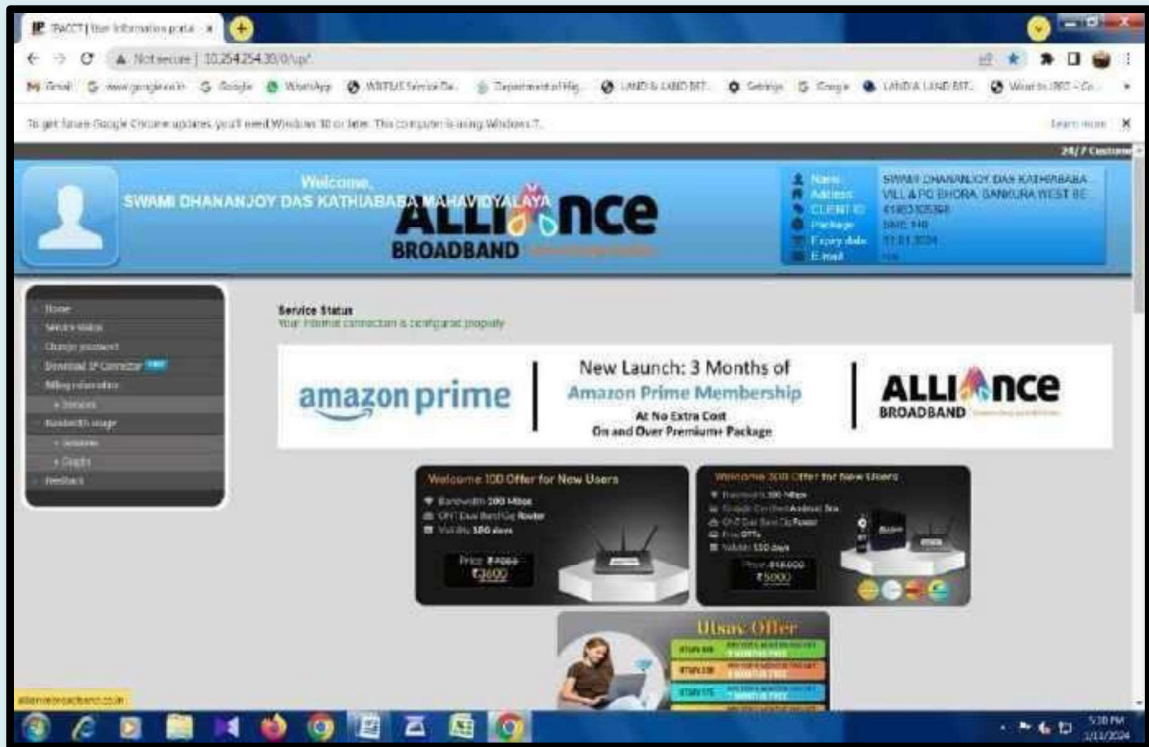
Our college being a rural college, is located in a remote area. Consequently, learning resources are meagre and largely inaccessible to the students who mostly belong to poor and needy families. It is under such a circumstance that the central library of the college turns out to be an indispensable factor in the day-to-day curricular activities of the college. It would perhaps not be an overstatement to say that the library forms the backbone of college.

As already mentioned, an overwhelming majority of our students are financially weak and cannot afford to buy even the text books prescribed in the CECS curriculum because of their high price, let alone the reference and background readings required to enrich their depth and understanding. Fortunately, however, they can access the college library and issue both text books and reference books. It is needless to mention that education in today's world is highly career oriented, and consequently the library subscribes to three monthly magazines that cater to this pragmatic requirement of our students. They are *Aspirers*, *Pesha-pradesh* & *Sajolito*. A large hall adjacent to the library, serves as a reading room with adequate sitting arrangements. This room is often used by the students for both group study and personal reading.

The library is open from Mon-Sat day (except holidays) from 10:30 am. to 4:30pm. The total no of printed volumes available in the library collection is a little over 11,000, of which books on :

GUIDELINES FOR FREE STUDENTSHIP SCHEME FOR UNDER-GRADUATE STUDENTS OF SEM-III & SEM-V OF ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023

Introduction:

Higher Education has had enormously played a role in the history to build the nation all over the world. It is not possible to rise in standards of living and culture without strengthening the higher education system in the country. To materialize as a powerful nation, there is an urgent need to bring in talented boys and girls in the fold of Under-Graduate education by way of providing them some sort of good incentives in the form of free studentship etc. The College Authority always stands by with the economically weak background meritorious students for higher learning.

Objectives of the Scheme:

- to promote and nurture talent
- to reward economically weak meritorious students at the Under-graduate level
- to build up academic excellence at Under-graduate level studied in this College

Eligibility for students who can apply under Free-studentship (Wavier) Scheme:

- Annual family income of the candidate must not be more than Rs. 1 lakh from all sources (supporting documents have to be attached)
- Candidate must be domicile of West Bengal. (Supporting documents i.e. **Aadhaar Card/Epic** have to be attached)
- Marksheet of Last Semester (i.e.Sem-II or Sem-IV of AY 2021-2022) is to be attached.
- Candidates selected under Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) Scheme of West Bengal Government or West Bengal Swami Vivekananda Merit-cum-Means Scholarship Scheme or enjoying any other Scholarship or Waiver Scheme will not be eligible under this Free studentship scheme of this College.
- Selected candidates fees(Half Fee/Full Fee) will be refunded though NEFT.
- For the purpose of determining Annual Family Income Certificate of the parents/guardian of the applicant students (considering all sources of Income of the family members), each student must submit original Income Certificate issued by competent Authority[at least B.D.O./S.D.O./M.L.A./M.P.]

Cancellation of Free Studentship:

- Misconduct of the awardees, if any, observed or reported.
- Unsatisfactory progress report, (having backlog papers in any semester)
- Candidates being found ineligible at a later date will face the penal action and will also be liable to refund the entire amount of free studentship.

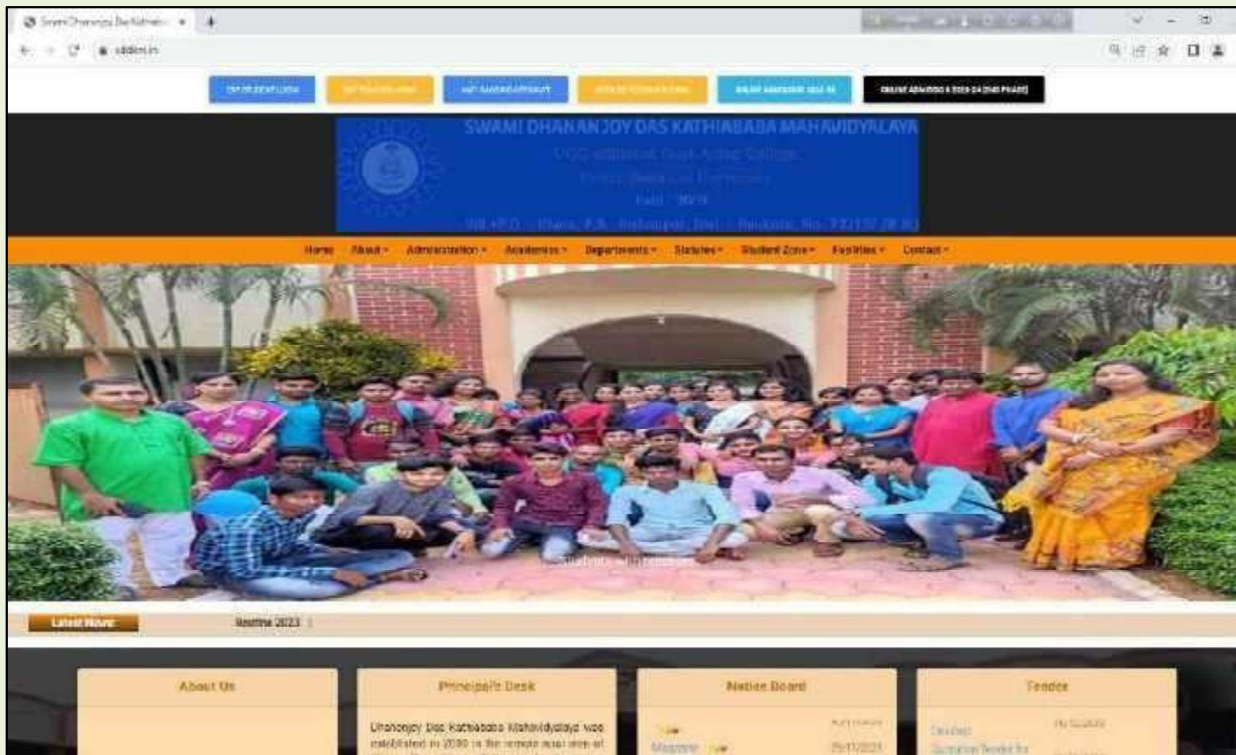
